- Builders' Risk, Apex, NC - 2023
Worked closely with municipality, fire department, and investigators for a new construction Builders' Risk. Review of drying goals and mitigation budget to reduce business interruption for a multi-unit residential building affecting six (6) units. Addressed safety and environmental concerns with a team of hygienists and engineers to assess damages consistent with electrical fire and smoke.

As a construction consultant, Mark joined efforts with municipalities, environmental crews, and teams of engineers and general contractors to determine accurate scopes and estimates ranging in complexity and value.
